All clubs offering rugby to children & young people need to:



Adhere to the IRFU Safeguarding Policy



Ensure coaches & volunteers have been safely recruited



Ensure a good ratio of suitably qualified or experienced coaches/ volunteers to players



Strive to create a physically & emotionally safe environment



Appoint a Club Welfare Officer (CWO)



Give all volunteers the opportunity to attend relevant training



Reinforce that activities should be fun & inclusive with a focus on playing & skills development



Ensure that all players are properly registered on the IRFU system



Make clear what the club ethos is
